

How to get to Jubilee Park

Parking for visitors

Show parking is marshalled by the Eastern Community Assistance Team, EA-CAT, whose members will help direct you before you arrive at Jubilee Park.



- We can only permit Passenger Drop Off and Disabled Parking at Jubilee
 Park due to the very limited amount of space available.
- There are several small car parking areas in Rendlesham, signposted for your use (Primary School, Doctors' Surgery and near Costcutter) but you might prefer to try our Free Park & Ride using Rockford car park and Tony Buckland's historic bus:

The Park and Ride will operate from 10:15am – 6:30pm completing the route from Rockford to Jubilee Park on a continuous basis **except 1:30 – 2:30pm** when the driver is taking a break at the Rockford pick up point.



Rockford have given us permission to use their car park and Tony of **Buckland's Coaches** is charging us a community rate to provide a shuttle bus. This means that the Park and Ride can be offered FREE to users. Thank you to both these wonderful Rendlesham businesses!
